



ALPHA ETA ALLIED HEALTH HONOR SOCIETY 2018 STUDENT RESEARCH PRESENTATION

The Alpha Eta National Allied Health Honor Society is sponsoring Research Presentations for students enrolled in or recently graduated from institutions that have Alpha Eta Chapters and who are Alpha Eta members. Abstracts of ORIGINAL research (not including systematic reviews) COMPLETED during the past year, can be submitted for consideration. **ONLY COMPLETED RESEARCH STUDIES WILL BE CONSIDERED.** Up to four papers will be selected for presentation at the Association of Schools of Allied Health (ASAHP) Annual Conference at The Vinoy Renaissance in St. Petersburg, FL which runs October 10-12, 2018, with twenty-minute Power Point presentations taking place on Friday morning, October 12th. Those selected will be given \$1,000 for travel expenses to attend the meeting and present their research. Research presented may have multiple authors (including faculty advisors), but only a single student author will be provided funding to help offset the cost of attending the meeting. Those selected are encouraged as well, to submit in poster format and presented as part of the ASAHP poster presentation session sponsored by the Alpha Eta Society. Each institution with an Alpha Eta Chapter can submit up to 5 abstracts. Submissions of research by undergraduate students are strongly encouraged. With the submission of an abstract, it is required that one of the student authors will present the poster if the abstract is accepted for presentation.

- 1) Two forms of the abstract: 1) abstract for review & 2) abstract for publication in program**

Two abstracts to be submitted:

- 1. Abstract for review**

- a. limited to 500 words**
- b. Title only on abstract and all identifying features removed**
- c. Each abstract must contain the following sections:**
 - **Background**
 - **Hypothesis/Question to be addressed**
 - **Method - Experimental design & methods used**
 - **Results - Observations/Outcomes**
 - **Discussion/Conclusion**
 - **Pertinence/Applicability to Field of Study**

- 2. Abstract for publication**

- a. Limited to 200 words**
- b. Capitalize the abstract's title. List names of author(s) using no titles or degrees, followed by the Institution affiliation in parenthesis. For example: SUBMITTING AN ABSTRACT FOR PRESENTATION: Jane Doe (University of Health Studies)**
- c. Again each of the above sections must be addressed in this version of the abstract.**

PRESENTERS WILL BE NOTIFIED AROUND THE FIRST WEEK IN SEPTEMBER IF THEIR PAPER HAS BEEN ACCEPTED.
