MINUTES

1. Call to Order: Lee Holder presided in place of Vincent Gallicchio
2. Introductions: Each of the 20 persons attending introduced themselves.
3. Minutes of the 2005 Houston Meeting were reviewed and approved
4. Treasurer's report was approved as presented. The funds went from \$14807.50 to \$16,916.57, plus a 5 year CD earning 4.589% totaled \$17,045.46. Total funds are \$33,962.03
5. Awards – There were no Rodenberg or President's awards this year. The winner of the Lee Holder Award for Excellence in Graduate Allied Health Education was Heather Shriver from Thomas Jefferson University.

She presented her research:

This was a pilot study done in Nymegen, Netherlands under Dr. Julie Mount. Two students go each summer - - a seven year relationship with UMC St. Radbond.

The pilot study was developed for analyzing facial sensibility and movement dominance.

Results: No statistical significance between dominant and non-dominant side of the face.

- women are more sensitive than mean with regard to monofilaments
- difference in sensation between the three regions of the trigeminal nerve distribution.

She also performed research on various other topics for Dr. Julie Mount.
